Excursions Consent Form

Introduction

The College has organised an excursion for your child to attend. All of the relevant details are provided below for your convenience. For your child to attend, you are required to read this information and complete this Excursions Consent Form.

The College recognises the value of relevant camps and excursions in allowing children to learn from these experiences. The College will actively seek to minimise any risks associated with excursions, and respond promptly and appropriately to any emergency whilst on an excursion.

College Camps and excursions occur only with the authorisation of the Executive Director and of the parents of the students involved. Gaining approval involves us providing information about the proposed journey on this Excursion Consent Form.

Camps and excursions occur only once a risk assessment has been completed. This assessment will identify potential risks ranging from the impact of the physical environment, activities and how it affects the supervision of personnel and students.

Practices and behaviour by personnel during an overnight stay will be consistent with the practices and behaviour expected during delivery of our College's programs at other times.

Privacy: The College is collecting information about you and your child in order to obtain consent for the College Camp and excursions. The information in this form may be given to outside personnel when directly related to the delivery of our College programs and services. Your information will not be given to any other person or agency unless the College has obtained your consent, or the disclosure is required or authorised by law.

Activity risks and insurance: Please note that the College does not have personal accident insurance cover for children/students. If your child is injured as a result of an accident or incident while participating in the activity, all costs associated with the injury, including medical costs, are the responsibility of the parent/carer. Some incidental medical costs may be covered by Medicare. If you have private health insurance, some costs may also be covered by your provider. Any other costs must be covered by parents/carers. It is up to all parents/carers to decide what types and what level of private insurance they wish to arrange to cover their child. Please take this into consideration in deciding whether or not to allow your child to participate in this activity.

I understand that the College may need to cancel or alter excursion arrangements at short notice, for safety reasons or due to circumstances beyond the control of the College. While the College will try to minimise inconvenience or financial losses to parents, these may be unavoidable.
